  - Your reason for application and the amount requested (up to \$1,000.00)
  - Date(s) of event or course
  - How the award will be spent (a budget)
  - How it will further your professional goals and enhance your professional services
  - If applicable, list other sources and amounts for funding received

*The recipient must submit proof of activity within ten business days of completion or return from travel.*

## HLA Student Scholarship

**Requirements:** UH-Mānoa LIS Program or Advanced Certificate student 1) currently taking at least six credit hours, 2) has completed at least one semester, and 3) will be attending school during Summer or Fall 2020 semester.

**Application must include:**

- This application form
- One page resume
- A statement, no longer than two pages double-spaced, describing professional goals and how this award will help you meet them--highlighting your leadership potential, professional promise, and potential for academic success
- A copy of your transcript (unofficial acceptable), showing: 1) your GPA in LIS/ICS courses and 2) you are enrolled in six or more credits for the Spring 2020 semester
- A list of current and next academic year scholarships, awards, and tuition waivers and amounts of each
- Minimum one letter of recommendation
